



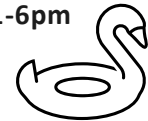

The Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

Beginning May 12th, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) announced that eligible households can receive a temporary discount on monthly broadband bill. The benefit may include the following:

- Up to a \$50/month discount on your broadband service and associated equipment rentals
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer (with a co-payment of more than \$10 but less than \$50)
- Only one monthly service discount and one device discount is allowed per household.

The program will end when the fund runs out of money, or six months after the Department of Health and Human Services declares an end to the COVID-19 health emergency, whichever is sooner.

Tax Relief - Did you know that senior and persons with disabilities who live in Loudoun County and have fixed incomes may be eligible for a **Personal Property (car) Tax exemption**? The county has already mailed 2021 Tax Relief Applications for renewals, but if you have not received a form please call 703-737-8557.


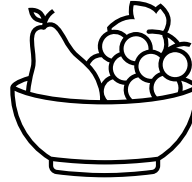
