

Winter Readiness Tips

At home:

- Locate an emergency heat source, like a fireplace, a wood stove, or a space heater.
- Store water and canned food
- Have a first aid and keep it accessible
- Keep track of flashlights and batteries
- Look over your insurance policy

In vehicle:

- Have an emergency kit in your vehicle in case you are stranded (Include food, water, medication, and anything used daily to last for at least 72 hours.
- Have a shovel, windshield scraper, and sand or cat litter for traction.
- Keep a portable phone charger, flashlight, and a toolkit in the trunk
- Store food and water in the vehicle

Make a plan to check on neighbors if extreme cold or winter weather knocks out your power.

Power Outage Tips:

- Dim your cell phone brightness to conserve save battery life
- Keep freezers and refrigerators closed.
- Disconnect appliances and electronics to avoid damage from electrical surges
- Go to a local community location with power if the cold is extreme
