The Middleburg Community Center will host a Christmas in July Luau at the swimming pool!



Beat the Heat!

Tips and tricks so that you and your loved ones can stay safe in the summer months.

How to prevent heatstroke:

- Hydrate often with cool water.
- If going outside, wear lightweight, light-colored clothing. Wear a hat or sunglasses to also avoid eye damage.
- Do not leave children or pets in cars for any amount of time.
- Monitor your animals frequently.
- Check on your neighbors: Especially older or young neighbors!
- Know the forecast and plan ahead.

Heatstroke Symptoms:

People suffering from heat stroke often run a high body temperature, express confusion or delirium, feel nauseous, and have a headache.

What to do BEFORE someone shows heat stroke symptoms:

1. Move the affected person indoors or under shade
2. Remove excess clothing
3. Cool the person with whatever means you have available: cold water, ice packs, soak clothes in water.
